CITATION IN HONOUR OF
REV. MERCY J. ISAAC
AT HER EPISCOPAL CONSECRATION



Beloved in Christ, today we stand upon holy ground. We gather enearth the canopy of divine providence to celebrate a life predestined, preserved, processed, and now presented for higher service in the household of God. It is with profound reverence that we read this citation in honour of Rev. Mercy Joseph Isaac, a vessel of grace, a herald of revival, and a daughter beloved of the Most High.

Born on 31st August 1983 into the devout Christian family of Elder William and Deaconess Mary Bassey, frontline members of Mount Zion Gospel Church, Calabar, Mercy's life began within the womb of worship and the atmosphere of apostolic conviction. Her earliest days were nurtured in a home where the altar of God was kept burning, and from childhood it became evident that the hand of the Lord rested strongly upon her.

From her infancy, prophetic streams flowed consistently in her direction. Among the many words spoken, one remains a cornerstone in her divine narrative: the 1989 prophetic instruction that she be adopted as a spiritual daughter of the late Bishop E. A. Bassey, then General Overseer of Mount Zion Gospel Church. This divine act was more than an adoption—it was a sealing of destiny, a prophetic alignment revealing the wisdom of the Almighty. Bishop Bassey stood not only as a father to her, but also as the early spiritual father and mentor to Archbishop Cletus Bassey, in whose lineage of grace and apostolic authority this consecration finds continuity today. Thus, God ensured—across generations—the preservation of an apostolic mantle, a heritage of fire and fidelity.

As a young girl, Mercy experienced vivid encounters with the Lord that shaped her spiritual consciousness. In her tender years at Hillside International Nursery School, Calabar, she boldly declared before teachers and peers that she would grow up to be a preacher, and that someday she would proclaim Christ even in Saudi Arabia. Such a confession from a child was no ordinary utterance; it was prophetic.

Yet, as with all great destinies, seasons of contention arose. Distractions and battles of her youth sought to divert her feet from the consecrated path. But the God who makes broken vessels shine, and broken crayons still colour, drew her back by His irresistible grace. In the year 2000, Mercy returned fully to her covenant calling—and from that sacred moment, she has never looked back.

For a quarter of a century—25 faithful years—Rev. Mercy J. Isaac has served tirelessly across multiple expressions of the Lord's vineyard with the earliest being:

- Vice President, Youth Fellowship Winners Chapel
- Junior WOFBI Lecturer, Winners' Chapel, Calabar.
- Head of Operations and Branch Pastor, God's Heritage Centre, Calabar.

As she advanced in her stewardship, Mercy boldly launched Generation with Power Ministries and House of Impact; both served as prayer and leadership networks for Church and Marketplace leaders with the latter being commissioned by Archbishop Prof. Cletus Bassey and Pastor Edwin Ogelenya, the then Provincial Pastor of Living Faith Church Cross River State in 2011.

Rev. Mercy would again be summoned by God in 2014 into the city of Uyo to serve God's purpose at another level.

The intentional love, support, growth triggers, responsibilities and spiritual exposure from her spiritual parents and mentors- Archbishop Cletus and Bishop Blessing Bassey and Prof. Ashong and Rev. Angela Ashong provided the platform for her initial service as

- Head of Programs, Cletus Bassey Ministries.
- Assistant Resident Pastor, Destiny Mission Global Assembly Headquarters.

It is important to note that she served her people as Supervisor for Education, Abak Local Government Area from 2020- 2023.

Upon her appointment as the Africa Director of LeadImpact University, she has been at the centre of organising, hosting, and ministering at Pastors' conferences and revival flames across East Africa, strengthening churches, empowering leaders, and rekindling apostolic fervour.

Rev. Mercy is joyfully married to Evangelist Joseph Isaac, her covenant companion in life and ministry, and together they are blessed with a precious son, Moses-Ian; a heritage unto the Lord.

Her ministry voice is distinguished by honour, accountability, prophetic intelligence, and revival consciousness. Through platforms such as Not Too Young For This and The Summon, she has ignited hunger for God, stirred dormant giftings, restored believers to prophetic confidence, and awakened the Bride of Christ to the urgency of the times.

Across denominational lines and generational boundaries, she has built bridges with grace and rare emotional intelligence.

Her impact has earned her many affectionate names like, Impact," "MercySpeaks," and "The Interpreter"—each testifying to her ability to clarify purpose, disentangle complexities, and translate divine burdens into practical wisdom for the Body of Christ.

Through her creative brilliance, strategic acumen, and prophetic activations, the Church of God has been enriched. Through her voice, destinies have been awakened. Through her life, many have found direction. And through her obedience, the apostolic heritage entrusted to her fathers has found faithful expression in her generation.

And now, with gratitude to God and joy in the Holy Spirit, Destiny Mission Global Assembly presents her for higher service. With solemnity and celebration, with honour and holy anticipation, we commend Rev. Mercy J. Isaac unto consecration as a Bishop in the Lord's Church—that she may continue to discern His voice, declare His will, deliver His purpose, and shepherd God's people with wisdom, courage, and apostolic insight.

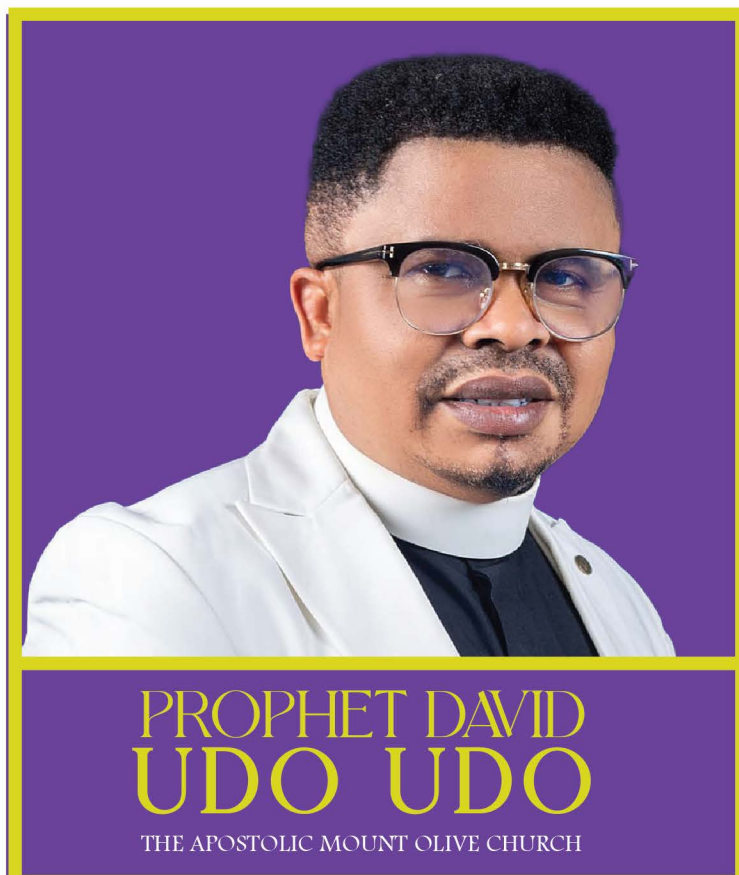


My Dear Reverend Mercy,

I congratulate you and your family for this great feat and wish you all the best in your Divine services.



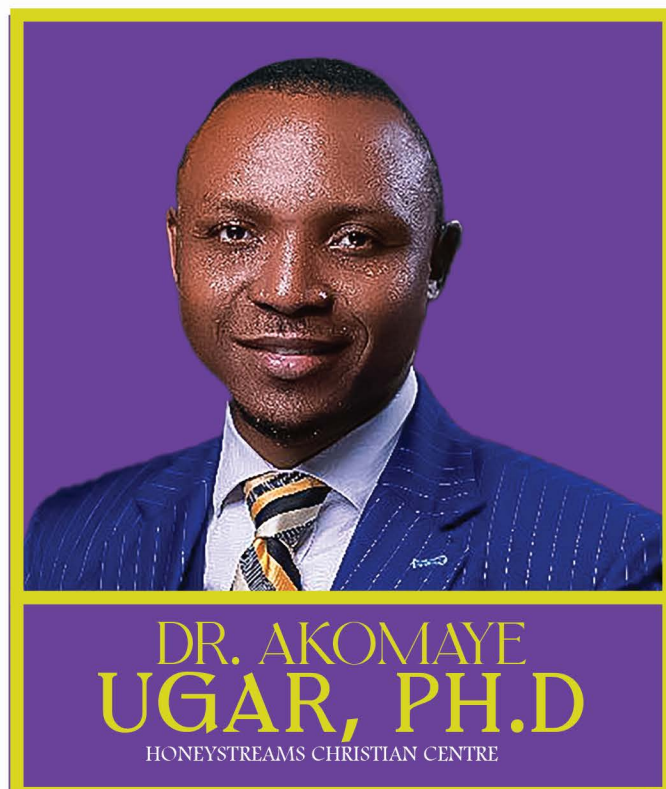

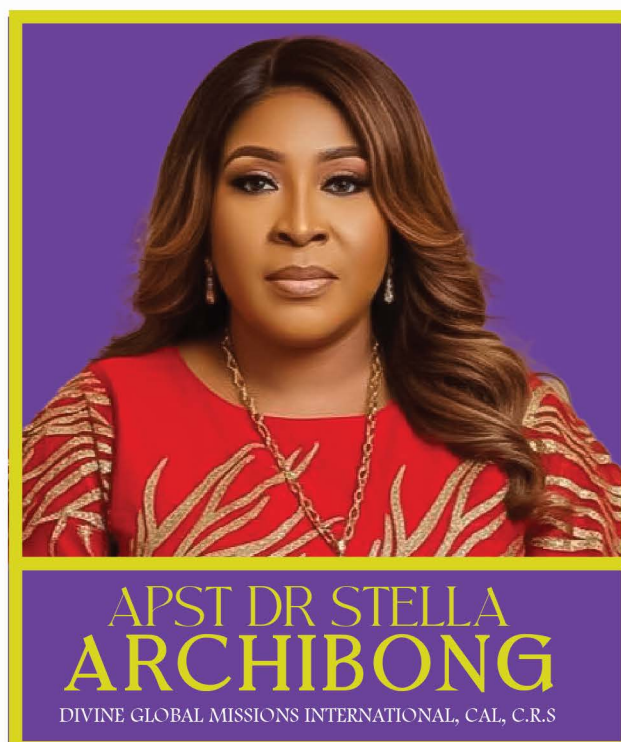


Congratulations, Dear, Bishop Mercy Speaks!

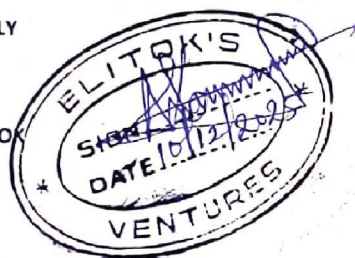
